

## 2. Rally



### Instructions

Students are on consoles of approximately 4. Every student has a paper with a basic, empty table on it. The teacher poses a question which has multiple correct answers. Each student has 10 seconds to write down one correct answer only in one cell of the table. After 10 seconds, the teacher calls "pass left" and each paper is passed to the student on the left.

This continues until the papers have circulated an appropriate number of times. Students will initially be able to reuse their first or most obvious answers but, as the activity progresses, they will need to think more deeply or broadly for correct responses. No repeat answers are permitted.
